The Judd Goldman Adaptive Sailing Program offers classroom and on-the-water instruction for the physically disabled.

While we want to serve all people who are mobility or visually impaired, participation in the instructional program requires:



A desire to attain sailing skills



An ability to float calmly in the water for five minutes while wearing a personal flotation device (life jacket).



Classes & Schedules

15 Hours of instruction (six 2 1/2-hour lessons) are available for beginner and intermediate sailors for \$100.00. A one-to-two instructor/student ratio is emphasized. Each participant can bring a family member for the lesson.

Scholarships may be available based on financial need. Applications for scholarships may be obtained by calling the Judd Goldman Sailing Center.

Races

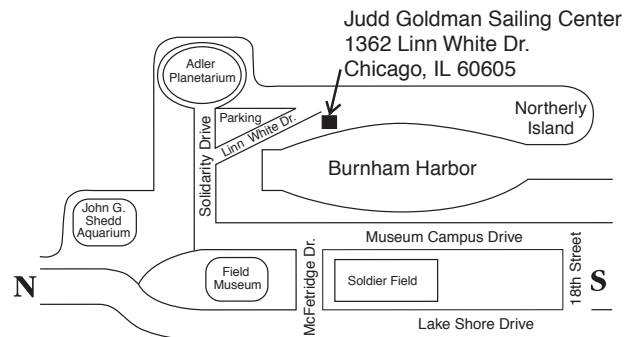
Races are held during the summer for those sailors with a competitive spirit.
